





Supported by a central office to provide management oversight, legal counsel, business operations, database operations

Probation and Parole Offices

Change offender behavior to become prosocial contributing member of society

- Work with offenders on legal statuses of furlough, probation, parole, and supervised community sentence
- Complete risk assessments and case plans to address the root of the offender's criminal behavior
- Develop release plans that leverage community and departmental resources to achieve successful reentry
- Coordinate with courts and parole board to supervise offenders under their authority
- Coordinate with community partners
 - Community Justice Centers
 - Behavioral and Mental Health providers
 - Employers
 - Law Enforcement

Correctional Facilities

Contribute to public safety while keeping offenders safe and preparing them for release

- Unified system of jails (short-term sentences/detainers) and prisons (longer sentenced)
- Confine people detained pre-trial by the court
- Confine people sentenced by the court to incarceration
- Complete risk assessments and case plans
- Provide medical, behavioral, and mental health services
- Provide risk and need reducing services (education, employment, cognitive behavioral programming)
- Collaborate with probation and parole staff on release planning
- Coordinate with courts and Parole Board for hearings
- Coordinate with community partners for release planning and volunteer services

Vermont Department of Corrections Common Language

Booking Statuses:

The following list describes the booking status for individuals incarcerated in VT correctional facilities (either in-state or out-of-state). Booking Status indicates the individual's circumstance relative to their court case.

Sentenced Statuses:

- Sentenced: convicted of crime(s)

-Sentenced/Detained: convicted of crime(s) and held pre-trial for other crime(s)

-Sentenced W/Hold: convicted of crime(s) and held for US Marshals or other jurisdiction -Sentenced/Detained W/Hold: (rare) convicted of crime(s), held pre-trial for other crime(s), and held for US Marshals or other jurisdiction

Detained Statuses:

-Detained: awaiting conviction for crime(s)

-Detained W/Hold: awaiting conviction for crime(s) and held for US Marshals or other jurisdiction

Hold Status:

Hold: being held for US Marshals or other jurisdiction

NOTE: Individuals in each booking status are considered in the custody of the Commissioner of Corrections. The Commissioner has authority to make release decisions for incarcerated individuals with a "sentenced only" booking status consistent with the law and taking public safety into consideration. All other booking statuses require action by another authority (e.g. the court), to release a person from incarceration.

Crime Types:

Incarcerated individuals are classified into different Crime Types based on the most serious crime for which they are sentenced, detained, or held. For example, 01:Fel./Serious. The number (e.g., 01) indicates the severity of the crime ranked from 01-11 from most severe to least severe. Next, the Crime Type displays whether the most serious crime was a felony (Fel.) or misdemeanor (Misd.). Finally, the category of crime is provided (e.g., Serious). See below for examples of each Crime Type. Each individual is counted once in the crime type data.

Crime Type Examples:

01:Fel./Serious: Aggravated Assault, Aggravated Sexual Assault, Murder **02:Fel./Person:** Assault and Robbery, Lewd and Lascivious

03:Fel./Property: Burglary Occupied, Grand Larceny, Arson

04:Fel./Drug: Dealing, Trafficking, Possession and Sale

05:Fel./MotorV: DUI 3 or more

06:Fel./Other: Obstruction of Justice, Fugitive

07:Misd./Person: Domestic Assault, Simple Assault **08:Misd./Property:** Unlawful Trespass, Retail Theft

09:Misd./Drug: Possession of drugs

10:Misd./MotorV: Careless and Negligent Operation

11:Misd./Other: Violations Conditions of Release

Current Race Data:

Race data are categorized as follows:

-American Indian/Alaskan Native: "AmerIndian/ AlaskanNative"

-Asian/ Pacific Islander: "Asian/ PacIslander"

-Black: "Black"

-White: "White"

-Some Other Race/ Unknown: "Other/ Unknown"

Asian and Pacific Islander were combined due to the low number of individuals who identify with these races. Some Other Race and Unknown were collapsed as neither provide information of the race with which the individual identifies.

Future Race Data:

Incarcerated individuals' race are collected at booking and stored in the Offender Management System. Beginning August 5th, the process for collecting race changed to assure more accurate reporting. With this change, race options improved and now includes definitions of each race option, with the potential for selecting multiple races. Additionally, the procedure for acquiring race information from the individual now reflects the race with which the individual identifies. Finally, Hispanic, Latino, or Spanish Origin is captured with a separate yes/no identification. Both Race and Hispanic, Latino, or Spanish Origin will require a selection. These new data will become available once these changes are fully implemented and utilized.

Gender Data:

Gender data are categorized as follows:
-Cisgender Female: Sex female, identifies female
("Female")

- -Cisgender Male: Sex male, identifies male ("Male") -Transgender Female: Sex male, identifies female
 - ("Transgender")
 - -Transgender Male: Sex female, identifies male ("Transgender")
 - -Intersex: A term referring to people who have physical markers that differ from the medical definitions of male or female ("Intersex")

NOTE: Transgender Female and Transgender Male were combined into one category: "Transgender" for this report.

Vermont Department of Corrections Legal Status Types and Authority

Furlough

- DOC grants release and sets conditions
- DOC has authority to violate/revoke
- DOC supervises

Probation

- Court sets conditions
- Court has authority to violate/revoke
- DOC supervises

Parole

- Parole Board grants release and sets conditions
- Parole Board has authority to violate/revoke
- DOC supervises






Community Supervision Population by Age (N=5,593)










