8 An act relating to making miscellaneous changes in education law

9 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

14 (d)(1)(A) For fiscal year 2023, the amount of the census grant for a
15 supervisory union shall be:

16 (i) the average amount it received for fiscal years 2018, 2019, and
17 2020, and 2021 from the State for special education under sections 2961
18 (standard mainstream block grants), 2963 (special education expenditures
19 reimbursement), and 2963a (exceptional circumstances) of this title; increased

1 (ii) the annual change in the National Income and Product
2 Accounts (NIPA) Implicit Price Deflator for State and Local Government
3 Consumption Expenditures and Gross Investment as reported by the
4 U.S. Department of Commerce, Bureau of Economic Analysis.

7 Sec. 2. STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION 2360 RULE SERIES; PARTIAL
8 DELAY

9 It is the intent of the General Assembly to allow educators and staff time to
10 adequately prepare for the delivery of special education services as required
11 under the State Board of Education special education rules series 2360, which
12 takes effect on July 1, 2022. Therefore, notwithstanding any provision to the
13 contrary under 16 V.S.A. § 164, the State Board of Education shall suspend the
14 implementation of rule 2362 and 2362.2.5 until July 1, 2023. The remaining
15 rules under the 2360 rule series shall take effect on July 1, 2022.
