H. 518 - An act relating to the creation of the Municipal Fuel Switching **Thermal** Grant Program

Page 1, Line 8: (1) establish the Municipal Fuel Switching Thermal Grant Program

Page 1, Line 11,12: assistance and award grants and loans to municipalities for replacing displacing fossil fuel heating systems with renewable and efficient heating systems; by adding, repairing, modifying, or replacing heating or cooling equipment with more efficient systems that can utilize renewable fuel.

Page 1, Line 18: Fuel Switching Thermal Grant Program

Page 2, Line 2: Municipal Fuel Switching Thermal Grant Program

Page 2, Line 5: Municipal Fuel Switching Thermal Grant Program

Page 2, Line 6: Municipal Fuel Switching Thermal grants

Page 2, Line 7,8,9: and replace heating systems in covered municipal buildings with renewable energy system to add, repair, modify, or replace heating and cooling systems in covered municipal buildings with more efficient options that can utilize renewable fuel.

Page 3, Line 4,5,6: to replace displace fossil fuel heating systems with renewable and efficient heating systems; by adding, repairing, modifying, or replacing heating or cooling equipment with more efficient options that can utilize renewable fuel in covered municipalities; and

Page 3, Line 9: and fuel switching low carbon thermal energy systems.

Page 3, Line 12,13,14: and experts in the field of thermal enclosure, energy efficiency, who are licensed and certified by the Department of Public Safety, Division of Fire Safety to work with both electrical and combustion heating equipment, and renewable building space systems, shall design the Program.

Page 5, Line 1: Municipal Fuel Switching Thermal Grant Program

Page 5, Line 3: Municipal Fuel Switching Thermal Grant Program

Page 5, Line 11,12: and fuel switching low carbon thermal energy systems;

Page 5, Line 13,14: to replace heating systems with more efficient renewable energy heating systems. add, repair, modify, or replace heating or cooling equipment with more efficient options that can utilize renewable fuel.

Page 8, Line 11: "Renewables" has the same meaning as under 30 V.S.A. § 8002 and 10 V.S.A. § 585.
