Context matters

Putting the 'science' in data science Ethics cannot be automated



Thoughts on Definitions

- "Algorithm" doesn't need to be fully automated, or computerized. How is it being used? The context matters.
- Unfairness: "...to discriminate *against any individual* on the basis of..."
 - In our audits we focus mostly on statistical discrimination -- differences between groups on average



Focus on Procurement

- This is a smart way to exert some control
- Key provision: any algorithm procured / licensed by the State should be open to an audit. Nothing in the contract should prohibit this.



Lessons from Prior Government Efforts

- Focus on high-stakes algorithms; may be distracting or even counterproductive to try for all
- Expect people to want to avoid doing this → enforcement mechanisms



Industries / Areas to Emphasize

"High-stakes algorithms"

- ORCAA suggests: those that affect liberty, finances, livelihoods
- Note new EU framework defines "high-risk" AI systems
