10 relevant to the applicant’s ability to faithfully and competently perform the
11 fiduciary responsibilities of the State board or commission position.

13 RECORDS; PERSONAL FINANCIAL HISTORY; REPORT

14 (a) On or before December 1, 2022, the Office of Boards, Commissions,
15 and Public Service shall report to the House and Senate Committees on
16 Government Operations with a list of:

17 (1) State board or commission positions appointed by the Governor or
18 designee for which personal financial records are relevant to an applicant’s
19 ability to perform the fiduciary responsibilities of the position; and

20 (2) State board or commission positions appointed by the Governor or
21 designee for which criminal background checks are relevant to an applicant’s
22 ability to perform the duties and responsibilities of the position.
