To Whom It May Concern:

The Board of Civil Authority of St. Albans City met on Tuesday February 8, 2022 regarding house redistricting. The BCA unanimously endorsed separating what is now Franklin 3-1 two seat district into 2 distinct one seat districts. This plan is endorsed by both incumbent representatives Mike McCarthy and Casey Toof who are cc'd in this correspondence. The new proposed districts are as follows:

- one seat district composed of St. Albans City Wards 1-4
- one seat district composed of St. Albans City Wards 5 and 6 along most of St. Albans Town now in 3-1 with some modifications- It is my understanding that Representative McCarthy has forwarded the detail of this proposal to House Government Operations Committee

The exact proposal as described requires St. Albans City Council to redraw ward boundaries as a prerequisite. The BCA supports two one seat districts and prefers this proposal; however the St. Albans City BCA supports two one seat districts in the event the ward boundaries are not redrawn in a timely manner. The reapportionment board majority map is our preference in this scenario.
