Re: Draft 2021-2022 House District Apportionment Plan

- A. The Town of Troy Board of Civil Authority (BCA) appreciates the opportunity to provide input to the 2021-2022 House District Apportionment Plan. The Town of Troy is currently split into two legislative districts: Orleans-Lamoille (Rep. M. Higley) and Orleans 2 (Rep. M. Marcotte and Rep. W. Page). The split, while unpopular, was agreed to by the BCA as the 2011-2012 House District Apportionment Plan was being drafted.
- B. At its most recent meeting, the BCA was fortunate to have had both Sen. R. Starr (Essex-Orleans) and Rep. M. Higley (Orleans-Lamoille) in attendance to provide an overview of the apportionment process and criteria and answer questions. The position of the BCA is summarized in the following rank ordered statements.
 - 1. Ensure the Town of Troy remains within its border and is not split. The Town has managed as a split legislative district as established in the 2011-2012 House District Apportionment Plan. While objectionable, the good people of Troy have been good neighbors with the promise of relief in future apportionment plans. For the 2021-2022 House District Apportionment Plan, we look to the promise that the Town be redesignated and not split its border.
 - Forming a 2-member legislative district inclusive of Troy, Jay, Westfield, Lowell, Coventry, Newport Town, and Irasburg. This hybrid would essentially combine the two legislative districts that currently splits the Town.
 - 3. The legislative district should not cross county lines, i.e., remain in Orleans County.
 - 4. Should Eden be required to remain within the same legislative district as Troy, it (Eden) should be designated as the split municipality.
