5 Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to reapportion
6 the members of the House of Representatives

7 An act relating to final reapportionment of the House of Representatives

8 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

9 Sec. 1. REPEALS

10 (a) 17 V.S.A. § 1893 (initial division) is repealed.

11 (b) 17 V.S.A. § 1893a (subdivision of initial districts) is repealed.

12 (c) 2022 Acts and Resolves No. 80 (an act relating to reapportioning the
13 initial districts of the House of Representatives) is repealed.

14 Sec. 2. 17 V.S.A. § 1893b is added to read:

15 § 1893b. HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES DISTRICTS

16 Notwithstanding the processes outlined in 17 V.S.A. chapter 34A regarding
17 the enactment of initial districts and the subdivision of initial districts, for the
18 2022 reapportionment of the House of Representatives, the State is divided
19 into the following districts for the House of Representatives, each of which
20 shall be entitled to the indicated number of Representatives:

1 southern side of the centerline of
2 Swift Street to the intersection of
3 Dorset Street; then southerly along
4 the western side of the centerline of
5 Dorset Street to the intersection of
6 Nowland Farm Road; then westerly
7 along the northern side of the
8 centerline of Nowland Farm Road to
9 the intersection of Spear Street; then
10 southerly along the western side of
11 the centerline of Spear Street to the
12 intersection of Allen Road; then
13 westerly along the northern side of
14 Allen Road to the intersection of
15 U.S. Route 7; then briefly southerly
16 along the western side of the
17 centerline of U.S. Route 7 to the
18 boundary of the town of Shelburne;
19 then westerly along the town line of
20 Shelburne to where it intersects with
21 Shelburne Bay; then northerly along

1 the eastern side of the town line of
2 Shelburne as it runs along Shelburne
3 Bay; then westerly along the town
4 line of Shelburne across Lake
5 Champlain to the state border of
6 New York; then northerly along the
7 state border of New York to the
8 boundary of the town of Colchester;
9 then easterly along the town line of
10 Colchester to the boundary of the
11 city of Burlington; then southerly
12 along the city line of Burlington,
13 then follow the city line of
14 Burlington to the point of beginning 1
15 CHITTENDEN-13 That portion of the city of Burlington
16 encompassed within a boundary
17 beginning at the point where the
18 eastern boundary line of the city of
19 Burlington intersects with South
20 Burlington Recreation Path; then
21 westerly along the southern side of

1 the boundary between the South
2 Burlington Recreation Path and the
3 Burlington Country Club to where
4 the South Burlington Recreation Path
5 turns north; then continuing westerly
6 along the southern side of the
7 property line of the Burlington
8 Country Club to the property
9 boundary line between 544 South
10 Prospect Street and 500 South
11 Prospect Street; then westerly along
12 the southern side of the property line
13 between 544 South Prospect Street
14 and 500 Prospect Street to where it

16 then northerly along the western side
17 of the centerline of South Prospect
18 Street to the intersection of Cliff
19 Street; then westerly along the

1 Route 7; then briefly northerly along
2 the western side of the centerline of
3 U.S. Route 7 to the intersection of
4 Spruce Street; then westerly along
5 the southern side of the centerline of
6 Spruce Street to the intersection of
7 South Union Street; then northerly
8 along the western side of the
9 centerline of South Union Street to
10 the intersection of Adams Street;
11 then westerly along the southern side
12 of the centerline of Adams Street to
13 the intersection of South Winooski
14 Avenue; then northerly along the
15 western side of the centerline of
16 South Winooski Avenue to the
17 intersection of Maple Street; then
18 westerly along the southern side of
19 the centerline of Maple Street to the
20 end of Maple Street; then continue in
21 a line due west to the boundary of

1 the city of South Burlington in Lake
2 Champlain; then southeasterly along
3 the city line of South Burlington,
4 then follow the city line of South
5 Burlington to the point of beginning 2
6 CHITTENDEN-14 That portion of the city of Burlington
7 encompassed within a boundary
8 beginning at the point where the
9 eastern boundary line of the city of
10 Burlington intersects with the South
11 Burlington Recreation Path; then
12 westerly along the northern side of
13 the boundary between the South
14 Burlington Recreation Path and the
15 Burlington Country Club to where
16 the South Burlington Recreation Path
17 turns north; then continuing westerly
18 along the northern side of the
19 property boundary of the Burlington
20 Country Club to the property
21 boundary line between 544 South

1 Prospect Street and 500 South
2 Prospect Street; then westerly along
3 the northern side of the property line
4 between 544 South Prospect Street
5 and 500 Prospect Street to where it
6 intersects with South Prospect Street;
7 then northerly along the eastern side
8 of the centerline of South Prospect
9 Street to the intersection of Cliff
10 Street; then westerly along the
11 northern side of the centerline of
12 Cliff Street to the intersection of U.S.
13 Route 7; then briefly northerly along
14 the eastern side of the centerline of
15 U.S. Route 7 to the intersection of
16 Spruce Street; then westerly along
17 the northern side of the centerline of
18 Spruce Street to the intersection of
19 South Union Street; then northerly
20 along the eastern side of the
21 centerline of South Union Street to

1 the intersection of Adams Street;
2 then westerly along the northern side
3 of the centerline of Adams Street to
4 the intersection of South Winooski

12 then southerly along the eastern side

15 Street; then westerly along the
16 southern side of the centerline of
17 North Street to the intersection of
18 North Winooski Avenue; then
19 southerly along the eastern side of
20 the centerline of North Winooski
21 Avenue to the intersection of Pearl

1 Street; then easterly along the
2 northern side of the centerline of
3 Pearl Street to the intersection of
4 South Willard Street; then southerly
5 along the eastern side of the
6 centerline of South Willard Street to
7 the intersection of College Street;
8 then easterly along the northern side
9 of the centerline of College Street to
10 the intersection of South Prospect
11 Street; then southerly along the
12 eastern side of the centerline of
13 South Prospect Street to the
14 intersection of U.S. Route 2; then
15 southeasterly along the northeastern
16 side of the westbound lane of U.S.
17 Route 2 to the boundary of the city
18 of South Burlington; then
19 southeasterly along the city line of
20 South Burlington and then follow the
21 city line of South Burlington to the

1 boundary of the city of Winooski;
2 then northwesterly along the city line
3 of Winooski to the point of
4 beginning 2
