Representatives Cordes of Lincoln and Donahue of Northfield move that the bill be amended as follows:

First: In Sec. 3, human services, in subsection (a), in subdivision (1), by striking out “Physically Secure Recovery Residence” and inserting in lieu thereof “Secure Residential Recovery Facility”

Second: In Sec. 3, human services, by striking out subsection (c) in its entirety an inserting in lieu thereof a new subsection (c) to read as follows:

(c) The amount appropriated in subdivision (a)(1) of this section shall be used to construct a 16-bed Secure Residential Recovery Facility on Parcel ID# 200-5-003-001 as designated on the Town of Essex’s Tax Parcel Maps for transitional support for individuals who are being discharged from inpatient psychiatric care. The design for the facility shall be for two eight-bed wings with separate living quarters that can function independently if necessary and with clinical and activity spaces accessible for use by both units. Neither wing shall include a locked seclusion area, and the facility shall not use emergency involuntary procedures. Outdoor space shall be adequate for sports and exercise activities, but not less than ten thousand square feet.
