#### **Comprehensive Suicide Prevention (CSP) Grant: Overview**

- 5-year grant from Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC)
- September 2020 August 2025
- Grant award to Vermont Department of Health (VDH)
- Co-Managed by Health Department and Department of Mental Health



#### **Comprehensive Suicide Prevention Grant: Funding**


- Grant Staffing:
  - Grant Coordinator
  - Data Analyst
  - Communications Coordinator
- Training, consultation, incentives and staff support to develop and improve suicide prevention services and resources
- Public-facing resources and messaging to help people find support
- Comprehensive Evaluation of Grant Activities

#### **Public Health Approach to Suicide Prevention**

- Emphasis on protecting health of communities and prevention among large groups of people
- Population approach and primary prevention are critical to suicide prevention
  - People at risk often do not seek help
  - First attempts can be fatal
  - Expand beyond mental health treatment system into communities and other programs

#### **Populations of Focus**





#### 1) Expand "Gatekeeper Training"

- Expand capacity for service providers and community partners to identify, support and refer individuals who are experiencing suicidality
- Priority implementation on programs that serve populations of focus
- 2) Reduce access to lethal means among persons at risk
- Promote Counseling on Access to Lethal Means (CALM) and Safe Storage Messaging
- Identification and mitigation of building structures or landmarks

#### 3) Expand Peer Supports for Individuals At-Risk

- Promote connectedness, mutual support, and help-seeking
- Develop/Expand Support Networks and Leaders among populations at risk:
  - First Responders
  - Farmers
  - Suicide Loss Survivors

#### 4) Improve Postvention Response to Suicide Loss

- Lessen harms and prevent future risk among individual who have experienced suicide loss
- Develop and implement improved training, resources and community response to suicide death

#### 5) Expansion of "Zero Suicide" in Healthcare Settings

- Safer suicide care through systems and organization change:
  - Comprehensive Screening and Assessment
  - Care Management
  - Clinical Treatment of suicidal thoughts and behaviors
  - Supportive Transitions Across levels of care and programs
- Focus on emergency departments and non-designated agency mental health providers
- 6) Increase Access to Mental Health Care via Telehealth
- Enhance expansion of tele-health to include suicide-specific support and treatment

#### **Year One Accomplishments**

- Improved Coordination across DMH + VDH
- Enhanced data analysis to support state-level planning
- Completion of State-wide Suicide Prevention Communication and Marketing Plan
- Recruitment of Additional Programs and Funding to Support Suicide Prevention
  - Invest EAP: Peer Support Networks for First Responders and Farmers; Engagement with Employers
  - VPQHC: Zero Suicide Implementation in Emergency Departments
