2	The Committee on Human Services to which was referred House Bill No.
3	225 entitled "An act relating to possession of a therapeutic dosage of
4	buprenorphine" respectfully reports that it has considered the same and
5	recommends that the bill be amended by striking out all after the enacting
6	clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
7	Sec. 1. INTENT
8	It is the intent of the General Assembly to decriminalize possession of
9	224 milligrams or less of buprenorphine. Persons under 21 years of age in
10	possession of 224 milligrams or less of buprenorphine would be referred to the
11	Court Diversion Program for the purpose of enrollment in the Youth Substance
12	Awareness Safety Program. Persons under 16 years of age in possession of
13	224 milligrams or less of buprenorphine would be subject to delinquency
14	proceedings in the Family Division of the Superior Court. Knowing and
15	unlawful possession of more than 224 milligrams of buprenorphine would
16	continue to be criminal and penalized in the same manner as other narcotics
17	pursuant to 18 V.S.A. § 4234.
