TESTS FOR TOTS AN EVIDENCE-BASED STRATEGY DEVELOPED IN PARTNERSHIP WITH THE EXPERTS AT THE VERMONT DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH

PROGRAM GOALS

- Tests for Tots was designed to provide testing opportunities for children 2–5 years old who are currently not eligible for vaccination so that <u>they</u> may remain in their child care setting.
- It also allows not fully protected staff, who are close contacts and test negative, to continue working <u>so</u> <u>programs can remain open.</u>

PROGRAM DESIGN

Child Care Programs

Parents

- Certify they will adhere to the program design.
- Eligible close contacts (children/staff) go home with test kits for 5 days of testing.
- If test is negative, they may attend the program.
- Staff and children who are actively testing mask indoors except when eating and napping.
- Children/staff who are sick stay home.
- Order more test kits when inventory runs low (more information coming soon)

- Tests child, if negative, child may attend child care.
- Certify their child will quarantine when not in child care.
- Certify they will test prior to attending the program and communicate results to the provider.
- Certify they will only use test kits for the enrolled child.
- Keep sick children home.

WHO'S PARTICIPATING ?

- 638 programs signed up
- 11,620 children
- 3,779 staff
- 15,399 test kits (10 per kit)

ADDITIONAL PROGRAM INFORMATION

- Program is voluntary for providers and parents.
- Testing options for children 6 weeks to 2 years old are not currently available.
- Staff and children who are fully protected do not utilize test kits. Staff (adults: primary series and booster. Five-year-olds: primary series was completed at least 2 weeks prior).
- A child's inability to mask consistently does not preclude participation.
