

DV/SV fund distribution

The Vermont DSVS Funds is governed by Vermont Title 32-Taxation and Finance-Chapter 7- Public Monies Subchapter 5-"Special Funds" <https://legislature.vermont.gov/statutes/chapter/32/007> The Center for Crime Victim Service acts as a pass through entity for this without any remuneration for the administrative costs for the quarterly payments, site visits, creation of award documents, strategic planning and auditing. In FY 21 the Center provided 19 subgrants to the 15 Vermont Network Programs. These grants included; the Vermont Criminal Justice Training Council for the mandatory DSVS training there, Heather Holter's position as the Coordinator of the DV Council, the Vermont Network for the Deaf Victim Advocate Program and a large \$329,195 grant to the Vermont Network that supports their director of policy and organizaing, finance director, economic justice and policy coordinator, director of learning initiatives, advocacy and trauma healing position, executive director, some administration expenses and subgrants of \$5,595 to each to the program offices for a total of \$90,015 to distribute to survivors to meeting housing and employment needs.
