4	(a) The Agency of Transportation shall ensure that all roadway projects
5	included in the Agency's Transportation Program spanning high-use corridor
6	segments identified in the On-Road Bicycle Plan prepared in April 2016, or a
7	subsequent update, include the improvement to or maintenance of a Bicycle
8	Level of Traffic Stress (BLTS) classification of 1 or 2, which indicates a
9	corridor that is either welcoming to most types of bicyclists or comfortable for
10	most adult bicyclists, or any other standard that the Agency deems appropriate
11	for the high-use corridor segment.
12	(b) Improvements may include, as warranted, the installation of roadway
