- Sec. 10. GRANT PROGRAMS FOR LEVEL 2 CHARGERS IN MULTI-FAMILY HOUSING

  (a) The Agency of Transportation shall establish and administer, through a memorandum of understanding with the Department of Housing and Community Development, a pilot program to support the continued buildout of electric vehicle supply equipment at multi-family housing and build upon the existing VW EVSE Grant Program that the Department of Housing and Community Development has been administering on behalf of the Department of Environmental Conservation.
- (b) In fiscal year 2022, the Agency is authorized to spend up to \$1,000,000.00 in one-time Transportation Fund monies on the Program established in this section.
- (c) Program funding will be awarded with consideration for broad geographic distribution as well as consideration for service models which examine strategies ranging from exclusive private parking to publicly accessible parking.
- (d) The Department of Housing and Community Development shall consult with an interagency team consisting of the Commissioner of Housing and Community Development or designee, the Commissioner of Environmental Conservation or designee, the Commissioner of Public Service or designee, and the Agency's Division Director of Policy, Planning, and Intermodal Development or designee on all major decisions regarding the design, award of funding and administration of this Program.
- (e) The Department of Housing and Community Development shall report the program outcomes to the House and Senate Committee on Transportation no later than January 15, 2022.
