# Incentive Programs Administration

---

- **Incentive Program for New PEVs**
  - \$3 million in FY2022
  - 10% (or \$300,000) allowable for administrative costs
- **Replace Your Ride Program**
  - \$1.5 million in FY2022
  - \$300,000 (or 20%) allowable for administrative costs
- **Electric Bicycle Incentive Program**
  - \$50,000 in FY2022
  - No allowable administrative costs (10% proposed)



# New Partnership

---

- **VTrans issued a Notice of Funding Opportunity for a third-party administrator in September**
- **Center for Sustainable Energy selected to manage the Incentive Program for New PEVs, the Electric Bicycle Incentive Program, and the Replace Your Ride Program**
  - CSE in partnership with VEIC to begin transition of New PEV Incentive administration from distribution utilities and Drive Electric Vermont this month (February 2022)
  - CSE to partner with VEIC on outreach, education and awareness—VEIC to develop informational materials, engage existing and new dealerships, and work with community-based organizations and other stakeholders to reach underserved Vermonters



# Scope of Work

---

- **Incentive Program for New PEVs**

- CSE to fully transition program in 3-4 months, designing new incentive processing platform onto existing Drive Electric Vermont website

- **Replace Your Ride Program**

- CSE to begin discussions with stakeholders, dealerships, scrapyards, retailers, etc. to inform program design and prepare for launch 1-2 months after PEV transition
- Phased approach to work with PEV and e-bike incentives first, then clean/shared mobility path

- **Electric Bicycle Incentive Program**

- Launch to coincide with Replace Your Ride or approval of admin costs
- Outreach and education to build public awareness of these programs



# FY2023 Proposed ARPA Budget

---

- **Incentive Program for New PEVs**
  - \$12 million
  - 15% admin costs
- **Replace Your Ride Program**
  - \$3 million
  - 15% admin costs
- **Electric Bicycle Incentive Program**
  - \$1 million (+ \$1 million for eRecreation vehicles)
  - 15% admin costs
