Subject: Taxation; property tax; trailer coaches

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to impose a moratorium on the taxation of trailer coaches as real property. The moratorium proposed in this bill would take effect upon passage and remain in effect until June 30, 2023. This bill further proposes to require a report to the General Assembly on or before January 15, 2023 from the Division of Property Valuation and Review of the Department of Taxes in consultation with the Vermont League of Cities and Towns and listers in rural communities with large campgrounds. The report proposed in this bill shall contain data on the value and stability of property tax revenue collected from trailer coaches that qualify as real property and recommendations for any legislative changes.
