Digital Intelligence Layer

- VT DOC requests spending approval of \$290,000 in JRI out-of-state savings to:
 - Evaluate methods, feasibility, and highest value opportunities, where a digital intelligence layer can be applied to best improve practice, correctional outcomes, and community-based supports.
 - This will result in an evaluation report detailing recommendations, priorities, and an implementation methodology.

Digital Intelligence Layer: Benefits

- Benefits of an intelligence layer overlay on DOC's OMS system:
 - JRI recommendations/outcomes implementation improvement
 - Seamless Supervision systems between Institutions and Community
 - Collaboration and information sharing between DOC and community providers
 - Improvements in data collection, data measures, and outcome measurement
 - Individualized Rehabilitative Case Planning
 - Improving Classification
 - Modernizing risk/needs assessment tools, systems, and processes

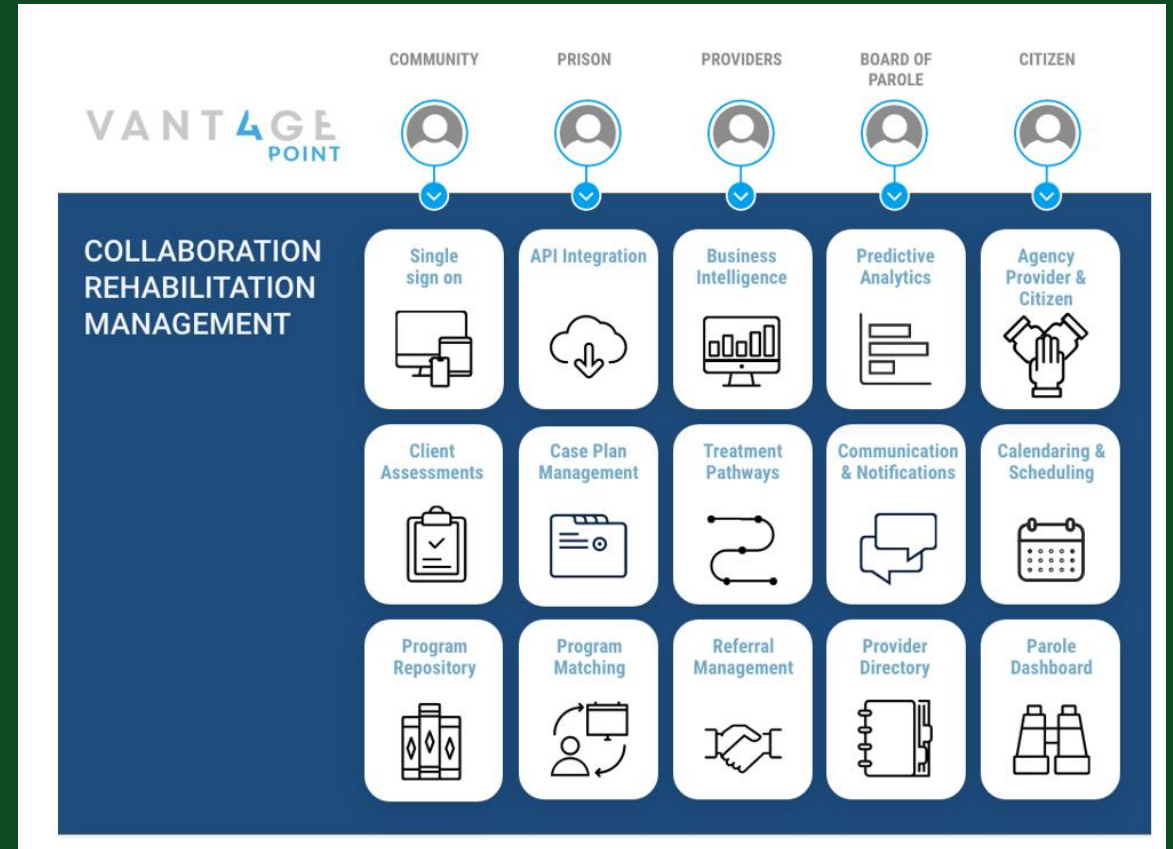

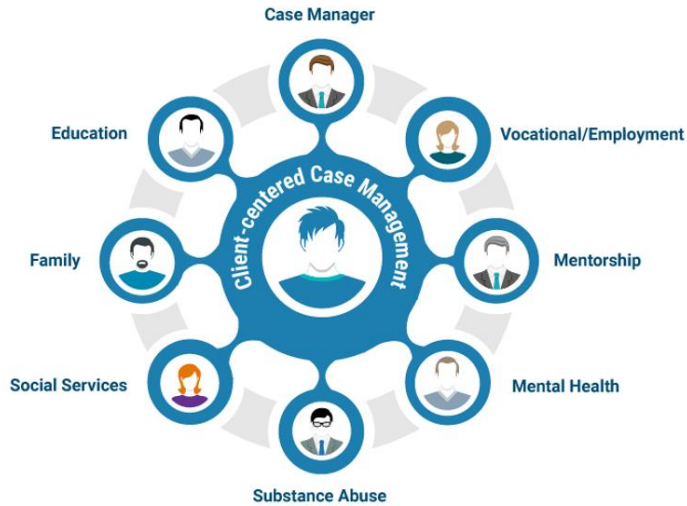

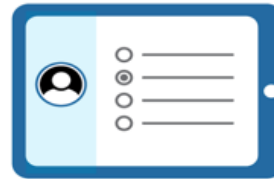


Continuum Of Correctional Care

Virtual Multi-Disciplinary Team

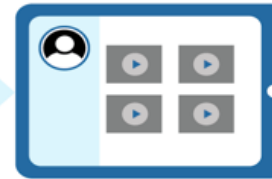

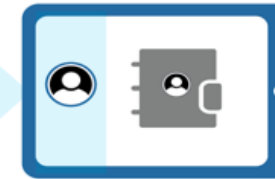
