After our submittal of the August 24, 2022, final proposed filing of Public Utility Commission Rule 2, we received feedback from Legislative Counsel concerning two of the sentences in proposed Rule 2.103. In response to that feedback, the Commission now wishes to amend our proposed rule by deleting the following two sentences from proposed Rule 2.103:

Additionally, whenever the Vermont Rules of Civil Procedure are amended or updated through an Administrative Order of the Vermont Supreme Court or otherwise, or at any other time for good cause, the Commission may, in its discretion and without formal rulemaking, incorporate any amended or new provisions of the Vermont Rules of Civil Procedure into these rules, or make any other changes to these rules, by Commission order. Unless there is a need to act immediately, the Commission will issue a proposed order for comment from stakeholders before the Commission issues a final order incorporating any amended or new provisions.

The rest of proposed Rule 2 remains unchanged. Along with this letter, I am also submitting a revised redline and clean version of the final proposed Rule 2 to reflect this change.

Please let me know if you have any questions, and we look forward to discussing proposed Rule 2 in the upcoming October 20, 2022, meeting of LCAR.
