9	Sec. 4. DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY; POSITIONS
10	(a) The Department of Public Safety is authorized to create five full-time
11	classified Inspector positions in order to conduct rental housing health and
12	safety inspections and enforcement pursuant to 20 V.S.A. chapter 172.
13	(b) The Department may hire additional Inspectors authorized by this
14	section to the extent funds become available from the Rental Housing Safety
15	Special Fund created and maintained pursuant to 20 V.S.A. § 2678(d).
16	Sec. 5. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY
17	DEVELOPMENT; POSITIONS
18	(a) The Department of Housing and Community Development is
19	authorized to create one full-time classified position and one half-time
20	classified position to design and implement the registry created in, and to

administer and enforce the registry requirements of, 20 V.S.A. § 2678.

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1	(b) The Department may hire additional staff authorized by this section to		
2	the extent funds become available from the Rental Housing Safety Special		
3	Fund created and maintained pursuant to 20 V.S.A. § 2678(d).		
4	Second: By striking out Secs. 14a (FY 2022 appropriation; VRHIP); 14b		
5	(FY 2023 appropriation; VRHIP); and 15 (effective dates) in their entireties		
6	and inserting in lieu thereof two new sections to be Secs. 15–16 to read as		
7	follows:		
8	Sec. 15. APPROPRIATIONS		
9	(a) Purpose. The purpose of the appropriations in this section are:		
10	(1) to respond to the far-reaching public health and negative economic		
11	impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic; and		
12	(2) to ensure that Vermonters and Vermont communities have an		
13	adequate supply of safe, affordable housing.		
14	(b) In fiscal year 2022, the amount of \$20,400,000.00 is appropriated from		
15	the America Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) – Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery		
16	Funds as follows:		
17	(1) \$100,000.00 to the Department of Public Safety as one-time startup		
18	funding to hire one or more Inspector positions authorized pursuant to Sec. 4		
19	of this act.		

1	(2) \$300,000.00 to the Department of Housing and Community		
2	Development as one-time startup funding to hire one or more of the positions		
3	authorized pursuant to Sec. 5 of this act.		
4	(3) \$20,000,000.00 to the Department of Housing and Community		
5	Development to implement the Vermont Rental Housing Investment Program		
6	<u>created in 10 V.S.A. § 699.</u>		
7	Sec. 16. EFFECTIVE DATES		
8	(a) This section and the following sections shall take effect on passage:		
9	(1) Sec. 1 (DPS authority for rental housing health and safety; rental		
10	housing registration).		
11	(2) Sec. 4 (DPS positions).		
12	(3) Sec. 5 (DHCD positions).		
13	(4) Sec. 6 (conforming changes to Department of Health statutes).		
14	(5) Sec. 7 (DPS rulemaking authority and transition provisions).		
15	(6) Secs. 8–10 (Vermont Rental Housing Investment Program).		
16	(7) Secs. 11–14 (Vermont Homeownership Revolving Loan Fund).		
17	(8) Sec. 15 (FY 2022 ARPA appropriations).		
18	(b) Sec. 2 (administrative penalty for failure to register rental housing) shall		
19	take effect on July 1, 2023.		

1	(c) Sec. 3 (repeal of registration exemption for housing provided as a		
2	benefit of farm employment) shall take effect on July 1, 2025.
