3	entitled "An act relating to banking, insurance, and securities" respectfully	
4	reports that it has considered the same and recommends that the Senate	
5	propose to the House that the bill be amended as follows:	
6	First: In Sec. 10, 8 V.S.A. chapter 148, in section 7122, in subsection (b),	
7	by striking out " <u>herein</u> "	
8	Second: In Sec. 20, 8 V.S.A. § 4728, in subdivision (c)(2), by striking out	
9	"but not limited to"	
10	Third: In Sec. 20, 8 V.S.A. § 4728, in subdivision (c)(3)(A), immediately	
11	preceding "process" by inserting the word protective	
12	Fourth: By adding a new section 23a to read as follows:	
13	Sec. 23a. DEPARTMENT OF FINANCIAL REGULATION; BROADBAND	
14	CONSTRUCTION; INSURANCE; GUIDANCE	
15	(a) The availability of significant federal funds coupled with the State's	
16	commitment to achieving universal broadband connectivity has resulted in an	
17	unprecedented period of broadband construction in our State. It is the purpose	
18	of this section to provide educational risk management guidance to broadband	
19	service providers engaged in broadband construction projects to reduce the risk	
20	of harm or injury to Vermonters, generally. It is not the intent of this section to	
21	establish new or expand existing rights, obligations, or remedies. Broadband	

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1	service providers should consult with insurance professionals and legal counsel		
2	when developing specific contractual terms and conditions.		
3	(b) The Department of Financial Regulation, in consultation with the		
4	Public Utility Commission, shall develop a guidance document that includes		
5	recommendations related to standard insurance requirements and measures that		
6	ensure adequate coverage is in force for the duration of broadband construction		
7	projects. The guidance shall be posted on a website maintained by the Public		
8	Utility Commission and shall be distributed by the Commission to every		
9	broadband service provider that registers with the State as well as to the		
10	Vermont Community Broadband Board for distribution to recipients of State		
11	broadband construction grants.		
12	(c) The Department of Financial Regulation may include in the guidance		
13	any recommendations for mitigating liability risk through safe cleanup		
14	practices on a broadband construction worksite and may include notification of		
15	the requirements pertaining to the proper disposal of solid waste as established		
16	<u>in 24 V.S.A. § 2201.</u>		
17	(d) The guidance required by this section shall be published on or before		
18	<u>September 15, 2022.</u>
