1	TO THE HONORABLE SENATE:		
2	The Committee on Health and Welfare to which was referred House Bill		
3	No. 711 entitled "An act relating to the creation of the Opioid Settlement		
4	Advisory Committee and the Opioid Abatement Special Fund" respectfully		
5	reports that it has considered the same and recommends that the Senate		
6	propose to the House that the bill be amended as follows:		
7	First: In Sec. 1, 18 V.S.A. chapter 93, in section 4772, in subsection (c), in		
8	the second sentence by striking out "Substance Misuse Advisory Council" and		
9	inserting in lieu thereof <u>Substance Misuse Oversight Prevention and Advisory</u>		
10	Council		
11	Second: In Sec. 1, 18 V.S.A. chapter 93, in section 4774, in subsection (a),		
12	by striking out subdivisions (1) and (2) in their entireties and inserting in lieu		
13	thereof the following:		
14	(a)(1) There is created the Opioid Abatement Special Fund, a special fund		
15	established and managed pursuant to 32 V.S.A. chapter 7, subchapter 5 and		
16	administered by the Department of Health. The Opioid Abatement Special		
17	Fund shall consist of all abatement account fund monies disbursed to the		
18	Department from the national settlement fund administrator, the national		
19	opioid abatement trust, the supplemental opioid abatement fund, or any other		
20	settlement funds that must be utilized exclusively for opioid prevention,		
21	intervention, treatment, recovery, and harm reduction services.		

1	(2) The Department shall include a spending plan, informed by the		
2	recommendations of the Opioid Settlement Advisory Committee established		
3	pursuant to section 4772 of this subchapter, as part of its annual budget		
4	submission, and once approved, the Department shall request to have the funds		
5	formally released from the national settlement fund administrator, the national		
6	opioid abatement trust, the supplemental opioid abatement fund, or any other		
7	settlement funds that must be utilized exclusively for opioid prevention,		
8	intervention, treatment, recovery, and harm reduction services. The		
9	Department shall disburse monies from the Opioid Abatement Special Fund		
10	pursuant to 32 V.S.A. chapter 7, subchapter 3.		
11	Third: By striking out Sec. 2, sunset; Opioid Settlement Advisory		
12	Committee, in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof a new Sec. 2 to read as		
13	follows:		
14	Sec. 2. SUNSET; OPIOID SETTLEMENT ADVISORY COMMITTEE		
15	The Opioid Settlement Advisory Committee shall cease to exist upon		
16	written certification by the Chair of the Opioid Settlement Advisory		
17	Committee to the Governor, the Speaker of the House, and the President Pro		
18	Tempore that Vermont's share of monies from the national settlement fund		
19	administrator, the national opioid abatement trust, the supplemental opioid		
20	abatement fund, or any other settlement funds that must be utilized exclusively		

1	for opioid prevention, intervention, treatment, recovery, and harm reduction		
2	services has been fully expended.
