10	not be used as a defense to defendant's criminal conduct, to establish a finding	
11	that defendant suffered from diminished capacity, to justify defendant's use of	
12	force against another, or to otherwise mitigate the severity of the offense:	
13	(1) evidence of the defendant's discovery of, knowledge about, or the	
14	potential disclosure of the crime victim's actual or perceived sexual orientation	
15	or gender identity, including under circumstances in which the victim made a	
16	nonforcible, non-criminal romantic or sexual advance toward the defendant; or	
17	(2) evidence of defendant's perception or belief, even if inaccurate, of	
18	the gender, gender identity, or sexual orientation of a crime victim.
