Vibration monitoring equipment was used to make sure levels were not dangerous to buildings.






Long runs of conduit for underground electric and communication lines being installed under driveways and through parking areas.








SITE PLAN

 2. REFER TO TYPICAL STAIR DETAILS FOR REINFORCEMENT, TRIM AND TREAD DETAILS. THE NUMBER OF STAIRS AND RISERS ARE TO BE BASED ON THE PLAN AND ELEVATION FOR EACH STAIR SET (NOT TO BE TAKEN FROM TYPICAL DETAILS). RISER DIMENSIONS TO BE ADJUSTED AS NEEDED TO PROVIDE EQUAL RISE AT EACH STEP. MINIMUM STAIR RISE 6", MAXIMUM STAIR RISE 7 1/4".
 3. ALL REINFORCING TO BE LEVEL (UNCOATED), LAP ALL NUMBER 4 BARS 1'-4" MIN.
 4. ALL VERTICAL SURFACES TO BE EXPOSED IN THE FINAL CONFIGURATION SHALL RECEIVE A RUBBED FINISH.






