Local Purchasing Initiative

- Governor Phil Scott signed H.106 and H.439 on June 8, 2021
- Provides a direct incentive to schools who meet local purchasing targets in their school meal programs, allowing them to serve more fresh Vermont food on their menus
- Act 67 creates a tiered incentive for schools, allowing schools to ramp up their local purchasing by providing 15¢ per lunch for 15% local food purchased, 20¢ for 20% and 25¢ for 25%

Farmers to Families Food Box Program

- Due to the Covid-19 Pandemic, we became involved in the USDA Farmers to Families Food Box Program
- We served over 95,000 boxes to families in need on the front line
- Over this period, we developed packing infrastructure
- The boxes coupled with the food chain shortages and lack of labor to hire, Vermont Blue Sky Packing was born

Blue Sky Packing

- Blue Sky Packing is the realization of our greater mission to be able to provide more local products into our accounts
- With our experience with the Farmers to Families Food Box Program it became clear that now was a good time to build this facility
- We are earmarking space in our facility for non-profits like Healthy Roots, to utilize as a local food hub
- This 20,000 square foot packing facility is currently under construction in Sheldon, Vermont
