2 Senators Collamore, Clarkson, Pollina, Ram Hinsdale and White move that
3 the bill be amended as follows:

4 First: By striking out Sec.2, 3 V.S.A. § 911, in its entirety and inserting in
5 lieu thereof a new Sec. 2 to read as follows:

6 Sec. 2. 3 V.S.A. § 911 is added to read:

7 § 911. DESIGNATION OF DEPUTY SHERIFFS PAID BY STATE;

8 STATEWIDE BARGAINING RIGHTS

9 Deputy sheriffs paid by the State pursuant to 24 V.S.A. § 290(b) shall be
10 part of a single, separate statewide bargaining unit for the purpose of
11 bargaining collectively pursuant to this chapter. The bargaining unit created
12 pursuant to this section shall be referred to as the State Paid Deputy Sheriffs
13 Unit.

14 Second: By striking out Sec. 4, effective date, in its entirety and inserting in
15 lieu thereof Secs. 4–5 to read as follows:

16 Sec. 4. 3 V.S.A. § 904 is amended to read:

17 § 904. SUBJECTS FOR BARGAINING

18 (a) All matters relating to the relationship between the employer and
19 employees shall be the subject of collective bargaining except those matters
20 that are prescribed or controlled by statute. The matters appropriate for

1 collective bargaining to the extent they are not prescribed or controlled by
2 statute include:

3 * * *

4 (8) terms of coverage and amount of employee financial participation in
5 insurance programs, except that the Department of State's Attorneys and
6 Sheriffs and the deputy State's Attorneys ~~and~~, other employees of the State's
7 Attorneys' offices, and deputy sheriffs paid by the State pursuant to 24 V.S.A.
8 § 290(b) shall not bargain in relation to terms of coverage;

10 Sec. 5. EFFECTIVE DATE
