PD Contract Office (all Primary PD Contracts) \$136,786

PD Staff office analysis includes CY 2020 salaries, benefits, and operating costs. PD Contract Office is based on FY 21 contract payment and operating expense cost. Caseload is pre-COVID FY 2020 ½. PD Contractors must provide professional liability insurance, pay the employer's share of FICA taxes, benefits (i.e., health, dental, life, retirement), and all operating expenses including rent, internet/phone, equipment and supplies. Contractors are required to participate in Public Defense annual training. Case-related third-party costs are paid directly to providers and are not included in this analysis. Contractors provide a 30% savings for the state over staff offices.

Assigned Counsel Contracts and Ad Hoc Counsel Cost Comparison

Note: Ad Hoc Counsel per LEC has decreased from \$366,735 approximately two years ago, likely as a result of the more serious cases being diverted to caseload relief contractors.

Assigned Counsel Contractors must provide professional liability insurance, pay the employer's share of FICA taxes, other insurances, and all operating expenses including rent, internet/phone, equipment and supplies. Contractors receive limited mileage reimbursement. They are required to participate in Public Defense annual training. Case-related third-party costs are paid directly and are not included in this analysis.

Ad Hoc Counsel analysis includes FY21 payments and FY21 added caseload. Ad Hoc Counsel are paid \$50 per hour for services and reimbursed mileage, telephone and postage costs. Caserelated third-party costs are paid directly to providers and are not included in this analysis.
