12 (a)(1) The Commissioner shall maintain an experience-rating record for

13 each employer. Benefits paid shall be charged against the experience-  
rating  
14 record of each subject employer who provided base-period wages to the  
15 eligible individual. Each subject employer's experience-rating charge shall  
16 bear the same ratio to total benefits paid as the total base-period wages  
paid by  
17 that employer bear to the total base-period wages paid to the individual by  
all  
18 base-period employers. The experience-rating record of an individual  
subject  
19 base-period employer shall not be charged for benefits paid to an individual
