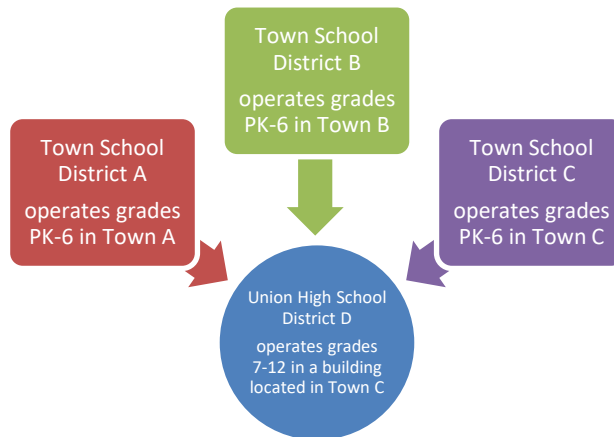


Union School Districts

- **School district** means “town school districts, union school districts, interstate school districts, city school districts, unified union school districts, and incorporated school districts, each of which is governed by a publicly elected board.” 16 V.S.A. § 11(a)(10).
 - Independent municipality
 - One town, multiple towns, or portions of a town
 - Maintain schools, tuition, or both
 - Governed by one publicly elected board
 - School board proposes a budget which is voted on
- **Union school district** means two or more school districts located in two or more towns that merged into one district that is responsible for the education of students in all grades for which it is organized, regardless of the town the student resides in.
 - **Union elementary and union high school districts** mean a union school district organized to provide for the education of students residing in two or more towns *in fewer than all grades*.



- **Unified union school districts** are union school districts that provide education for all PreK-12 students residing within its borders.
