Overview VPA:

- Founded 1915 as VT Headmasters (Became VPA 1989)
- Oversight of high school sports founding principle
- Has involved into the organization we have today
- Membership Driven Organization
 - o Members are Schools AND
 - o Individuals (mostly principals/assistant principals/AD's but quite a few Superintendent and other central office positions)

• Now VPA:

- o 5 employees for the entire state
- o Provides professional learning for members and other educational leaders in VT (and sometimes nationally)
- o Run a nationally trained mentoring program for new school leaders
- o Advocates for school leaders and students at the state and national level
- o Provides oversight of high school extracurricular activities through member committees and provides state championships

• VPA Governance:

- o Executive Council
 - Work directly with Executive Director Jay Nichols
 - 15 members
 - One retired principal, one assistant principal, and one CTE Director

- Governing Body of VPA. Oversees VPA similar to a school board overseeing a school district
- Boards seeks to be geographically, gender, school level and size diverse
- o Professional Learning & Support Committee
 - Work directly with Assistant Executive Director Mike McRaith
 - Oversees professional learning
 - 10 member committee principals and Central Office leaders
 - Plan the Annual Vermont Leadership Academy and other leadership learning events
- o Activity Standards Committee
 - Work directly with Associate Executive Director Bob Johnson
 - Regulates all middle school through high school sports and activities
 - Oversight with school districts of all high school playoffs in state
 - 28 sports, almost 80 state championships!
- o Main member Benefits:
 - Weekly Electronic newsletter
 - Updates weekly, research on leadership and instruction
 - Advocacy updates nationally and state
 - Legislative updates nationally and state
 - Members only access to website with many resources
 - \$1000 of legal job protection
 - Priority access to the Waddington School Leadership Initiative
 - Reduced fees to professional events
 - 24 hour access to executive director for leadership support
 - Ability to serve on leadership committees
