Subject: Follow up on Governor's tax relief proposals

Hi Senator Cummings,

Attached and below is a follow up for the Committee on the Governor's tax relief proposals as requested by members that includes number of taxpayers helped, and additional details by income band. Of course, I am more than happy to return to the Committee to discuss these details in testimony. As always, we are also working with JFO on these figures, but they are not currently consensus.

There are a couple outstanding requests from the Committee that we're still working on:

- A question from Senator Pearson about putting a growth factor on social security exemption cost over time (we're working on this with JFO)
- A question from Senator Sirotkin if at-home care workers would qualify for the nursing income tax credit
- A question about the cost breakout on military retirement pay exemption between retired enlisted folks and officers – we've acquired some data on this and I would be ready to speak to the cost breakout between enlisted and officer next time I am in committee.

If you have recollection of any additional requests that I haven't covered here, or if the documents lead to additional questions ahead of me returning to the Committee, please don't hesitate to reach out. Have a great weekend, I look forward to discussing the proposals in more detail.
