13	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
14	Sec. 1. ANNUAL MEETINGS IN THE YEAR 2022; TEMPORARY
15	PROCEDURES; CANDIDATES FOR LOCAL OFFICE; SCHOOL
16	DISTRICT BALLOTS
17	(a) Notwithstanding 17 V.S.A. § 2681(b) or any other provision of law
18	to the contrary, a person shall not be required to collect voter signatures in
19	order to have the person's name placed on the ballot as a candidate for a local
20	election that is held at a 2022 annual municipal meeting.

1	(b) Notwithstanding 16 V.S.A. §§ 706w and 711e, any other provision of
2	law, or any school district article of agreement that requires the ballots of
3	member municipalities to be commingled by the district, the legislative body
4	of a school district may vote that ballots for the 2022 annual district meeting
5	shall not be commingled before counting. The ballots may be counted by each
5	member town and the results reported to the school district clerk for
7	determination of the official district-wide results.
