17	(b)(1) Full-time deputy sheriffs whose primary responsibility is
18	transportation of prisoners and persons with a mental condition or psychiatric
19	disability shall be paid by the State of Vermont and shall be State employees

within the classified service as defined pursuant to 3 V.S.A. § 311. The

1	appointment of such the deputies and their salary shall be approved by the
2	Governor or his or her designee.
3	(2) The Executive Committee of the Vermont Sheriffs Association and
4	the Executive Director of the Department of State's Attorneys and Sheriffs
5	shall jointly have authority for the assignment of position locations in the
6	counties of State-paid State-employed deputy sheriffs and shall review the
7	county location assignments periodically for efficient use of resources.
