2	2	State Buildings	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Adds language in subdivision (d)(1) associated with the \$6,800,000 appropriation for renovations of the HVAC system in the State House requiring BGS to submit a proposal to the House Committee on Corrections and Institutions and the Senate Committee on Institutions with options for a heating source for a system to dehumidify the State House by January 15, 2023.</li> <li>• Adds language in subdivision (d)(2) requiring that no funds are expended on a heating source for a system to dehumidify the State House until the General Assembly approves the proposal submitted by BGS.</li> </ul>
3	3	Human Services	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Removes \$1,000,000.00 appropriation to nursing school programs and language directing the Secretary of Administration to issue an ROI for a capital grant program (funds are instead directly appropriated in Secs. 5 and 6, and a reporting requirement is added in Sec. 19).</li> </ul>
5	5	Vermont Colleges	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Adds an \$800,000 appropriation for renovation of simulation laboratories for nursing programs.</li> <li>• Adds a requirement directing the Chancellor of the State Colleges to submit a report to the House Committee on Corrections and Institutions and the Senate Committee on Institutions with an accounting of how the appropriation was spent and any unexpended funds by January 15, 2023.</li> </ul>
	6	Norwich University	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Adds a \$200,000 appropriation for construction of simulation laboratories for the University’s nursing program.</li> <li>• Adds a requirement directing the President of the University to submit a report to the House Committee on Corrections and Institutions and the Senate Committee on Institutions with an accounting of how the appropriation was spent and any unexpended funds by January 15, 2023.</li> </ul>
6	7	Natural Resources	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Separates the \$50,000 appropriation to the Lake Champlain Walleye Association into two separate \$25,000 appropriations; the first is for “repairs and upgrades” and the second is for “the purchase of self-cleaning tanks”</li> </ul>

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	19	Nursing School Programs; Simulation Laboratories; Report	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Directs the State Colleges, UVM, and Norwich University to each submit a report to the House Committees on Commerce and Economic Development and on Health Care and to the Senate Committees on Economic Development, Housing and General Affairs and on Health and Welfare detailing the infrastructure and programming needs, estimated costs, and timeline to renovate or construct nursing simulation laboratories by January 15, 2023.</li></ul>
	20	General Assembly; State Buildings; Use of Space; Authority of Sergeant at Arms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Amends past session law from the 2020 Budget Bill and the 2021 Capital Bill (2020 Acts and Resolves No. No. 154, E.126.3, as amended by 2021 Acts and Resolves No. 50, Sec. 31) permitting the Legislative Branch to have exclusive use of certain properties/rooms in the Capitol Complex by extending the Legislature's authority to use certain spaces on the second floor of 109 State Street until June 30, 2023.</li></ul>
