We would instead propose that the committee revise Sec. 1. 13 V.S.A. § 1455 to read "A person who commits, causes to be committed, or attempts to commit any crime and intentionally selects the victim on the basis of their whose conduct is maliciously motivated by the victim's actual or perceived race, color, religion, national origin, sex, ancestry, age, service in the U.S. Armed Forces, disability as defined by 21 V.S.A. § 495d(5), sexual orientation, or gender identity shall be subject to the following penalties:"
