Questions from the Committee

- 1. What is the cost of the new structure as proposed in the EO?
- 2. What is the cost of the 2 new full time Board Members?
- 3. What is the cost of the additional staff support necessary?

The total estimated cost is \$500,000 with Personnel costs including benefits estimated at \$350,112.00 and Operating costs estimated at \$149, 888.00

4. What impact will there be to the ongoing operations of the District Offices?

No financial impact on the operations of the District offices is anticipated.

- 5. Are there other financial implications that the Committee should be aware of?
- 6. Has the NRB/Act250 contemplated any means of funding the new structure on an ongoing basis?

The Committee should be aware that the Governor has included \$500,000 in his recommended budget for FY2022.

In addition, after many difficult years with unpredictable special fund revenues, the Governor has also added \$1,000,000 to his recommendations to fill the current NRB/Act250 deficit of (-\$647,389). and provide some resources to avoid future deficits.

These changes came about as a direct result of the Governor's support for the new NRB/Act 250 structure, and our internal budget work with Finance and Management.
