1	Sec. X. SALE OF STATE SURPLUS VEHICLES
2	(a) The Department of Buildings and General Services shall establish a
3	policy, consistent with 3 V.S.A. § 217 and 29 V.S.A. § 1556(a)(1) and (7), on
4	the sale of surplus vehicles at fair market value to the following:
5	(1) the Department for Children and Families for participants in Reach
6	<u>Up;</u>
7	(2) Capstone Community Action for participants in MileageSmart; and
8	(3) the Department of Disabilities, Aging and Independent Living for
9	participants in any of the Vocational Rehabilitation programs.
10	(b) The policy required under subsection (a) of this section shall, at a
11	minimum, address:
12	(1) how the Department of Buildings and General Services determines
13	the fair market value sales price for surplus vehicles;
14	(2) how, and under what timeline, the Department of Buildings and
15	General Services makes the surplus vehicles exclusively available for purchase
16	by the Department for Children and Families, Capstone Community Action,
17	and the Department of Disabilities, Aging and Independent Living;
18	(3) the process for the Department for Children and Families, Capstone
19	Community Action, or the Department of Disabilities, Aging and Independent
20	Living to have a surplus vehicle inspected prior to purchase;

1	(4) what happens with the proceeds from a sale of a surplus vehicle to
2	the Department for Children and Families, Capstone Community Action, or the
3	Department of Disabilities, Aging and Independent Living; and
4	(5) how to track the disposal of surplus vehicles as a State asset upon
5	conveyance to a participant in Reach Up, MileageSmart, or a Vocational
6	Rehabilitation Program.
7	(c) The Commissioner of Buildings and General Services shall enter into
8	one or more memorandums of understanding related to the sale of surplus
9	vehicles under the policy required under subsection (a) of this section.
10	(d) The Department of Buildings and General Services shall provide an
11	oral update to the House and Senate Committees on Transportation regarding
12	the implementation of the policy required under subsection (a) of this section
13	during the 2023 legislative session.
