Prohibited Conduct	Insider Participation:	Operators, employees, household family members, professional athletes participating in real world sports of the fantasy sports contest prohibited from play. 9 V.S.A. §4186(1)(a)	Insider Information; disclosure of confidential fantasy sports contest information to an unauthorized person prohibited. 9 V.S.A. §4186(2)				
Age	18 and older; authentication. 9 V.S.A. §4186(3)						
Limitations and Disclosures	Number of Entries. 9 V.S.A. §4186(4)	One username/account. 9 V.S.A. §4186(5)	Prohibit use of computer scripts to gain competitive advantage. 9 V.S.A. §4186(6)	Segregate player funds from operational funds, maintain reserves to cover all player accounts and payouts. 9 V.S.A. §4186(7)	Notify fantasy sports players that winnings of a certain amount may be subject to income taxation. 9 V.S.A. §4186(8)	Other Obligations: 9 V.S.A. §4186(b)	Link to information and resources addressing gambling addiction. 9 V.S.A. §4186(b)(1)
Limitations and Disclosures Cont.	Voluntary restricted access (for prescribed periods of time at election of the player). 9 V.S.A. §4186(b)(2)(A)	Required notice; operator must provide. 9 V.S.A. §4186(b)(2)(B)	Available resources addressing addiction and compulsive behavior. 9 V.S.A. §4186(b)(2)(B)(i)	How to close an account and restrictions on opening a new account during the period of self-restriction. 9 V.S.A. §4186(b)(2)(B)(ii)	Requirements to reinstate an account at the end of the period. 9 V.S.A. §4186(b)(2)(B)(iii)	How the operator addresses reward points and account balances during and after the period of self-restriction, and when the player closes his or her account. 9 V.S.A. §4186(b)(2)(B)(iv)	Access to information (prior 6 months). 9 V.S.A. §4186(b)(3)
Limitations and Disclosures Cont.	A player's play history, including money spent, games played, previous line-ups, and prizes awarded. 9 V.S.A. §4186(b)(3)(A)	A player's account details, including deposit amounts, withdrawal amounts, and bonus information, including amounts remaining for a pending bonus and amounts released to the player. 9 V.S.A.	Third party audit to ensure compliance. 9 V.S.A. §4186(c)(1)	Audits provided to the Attorney General. 9 V.S.A. §4186(c)(2)	No credit from operator to players. 9 V.S.A. §4186(d)	No fantasy sports for college, high school, or youth athletic events. 9 V.S.A. §4186(e)
