	<u>Pros</u>	<u>Cons</u>
1: Only use statehouse, Senate committees share - follow HVAC room limitations	all together	limited/less public access senate committees share
2: Use Statehouse and 109 - Senate committees share - follow HVAC room limitations 2a: use 109 for a few committees, leaving lounge & 11 avail for public meetings 2b: keep more committees in statehouse, use 109 for public meetings 2c: tear down house committee walls, keep all committees in statehouse, use 109 for public meetings	more large committee rooms 109 provides more public access space bigger public meeting rooms keeps all/ almost all committees in statehouse	transportation between buildings senate committees share some committees out of the statehouse public meeting rooms not as big as lounge and 11, joint committees likely on floor 109 Requires more security esp after 4:30
Option 3: use statehouse, 109 and 133 - follow HVAC room limitations	even more large committee rooms no senate committees share	security and transportation and coordination harder in 3 buildings
Option 4: ignore HVAC airflow analysis and come back as before	simple more public allowed in	ignores industry standards for HVAC some people will feel uncomfortable
