## No. 140. An act relating to designating Juneteenth as a legal holiday.

(S.206)

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. 1 V.S.A. § 371(a) is amended to read:

- (a) The following shall be legal holidays:
  - (1) New Year's Day, January 1;
  - (2) Martin Luther King, Jr.'s Birthday, the third Monday in January;
  - (3) Presidents' Day, the third Monday in February;
  - (4) Town Meeting Day, the first Tuesday in March;
  - (5) Memorial Day, the last Monday in May;
  - (6) Juneteenth, June 19;
  - (6)(7) Independence Day, July 4;
  - (7)(8) Bennington Battle Day, August 16;
  - (8)(9) Labor Day, the first Monday in September;
  - (9)(10) Indigenous Peoples' Day, the second Monday in October;
  - (10)(11) Veterans' Day, November 11;
  - (11)(12) Thanksgiving Day, the fourth Thursday in November;
  - (12)(13) Christmas Day, December 25.

Sec. 2. REPEAL

1 V.S.A. § 375 (designating Juneteenth as a commemorative day) is repealed.

## Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE
