16	(a) An administrative officer, who may hold any other office in the
17	municipality other than membership in the board of adjustment or,
18	development review board, shall the legislative body, or the local or regional
19	planning commission may be nominated by the planning commission and
20	appointed by the legislative body for a term of three years promptly after the

1	adoption of the first bylaws or when a vacancy exists. The compensation of
2	the administrative officer shall be fixed under sections 932 and 933 of this title
3	and the officer shall be subject to the personnel rules of the municipality
4	adopted under sections 1121 and 1122 of this title. The administrative officer
5	shall administer the bylaws literally and shall not have the power to permit any
6	land development that is not in conformance with those bylaws. An
7	administrative officer may be removed for cause at any time by the legislative
8	body after consultation with the planning commission.
