12	§ 1092. DAMAGING SURFACE OF ROAD
13	(a) No Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, a person may
14	shall not operate or move upon or over any highway or bridge a vehicle,
15	machine, or contrivance which:
16	(1) that has any flange, ribs, clamps, or other object attached to or made
17	a part of, its wheels which that will injure, cut into, or destroy the surface of
18	the highway or bridge to any appreciable extent-; or

1	(2) This provision does not restrict the right of any person to use with
2	tires which are equipped with "studs" or "cleats," so-called, studs or cleats of a
3	type designed for general use to facilitate travel in winter.
4	(b) The prohibition in subdivision (a)(2) of this section shall not apply:
5	(1) from November 1 to May 15;
6	(2) to vehicles not registered or required to be registered in Vermont;
7	(3) to farm tractors; or
8	(4) to authorized emergency vehicles.
9	(c) In addition to any liability for damage otherwise provided by law, a
10	person who violates subdivision (a)(2) of this section shall be subject to:
11	(1) a warning for a first violation; and
12	(2) a civil penalty of not less than \$100.00 for a second or subsequent
13	violation.
