Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to create the  
Legislative Office of Government Accountability and Strategic Planning in the  
Legislative Branch to assist the General Assembly in monitoring and  
improving the performance of State government; evaluating the operations and  
efficacy of State agencies, departments, and programs; developing strategies to  
harness Vermont's strengths through prioritized investments in individuals and  
businesses, the economy, the natural environment, and infrastructure; assessing  
the extent to which State government is sufficiently and appropriately staffed  
to meet its obligations; and ensuring that public funds are being used  
appropriately and in the manner for which they were appropriated or otherwise  
allocated.
