Subject: Transportation; electric vehicle supply equipment (EVSE); direct-
current fast chargers; welcome centers

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to require the
Agency of Transportation to explore the feasibility of installing direct-current
fast chargers (DCFC), also known as level 3 chargers or level 3 electric vehicle
supply equipment (EVSE), at former welcome centers in Vermont and, if it is
possible, from both a technological and compliance with federal law
perspective, to install DCFCs at former welcome centers in Vermont, update
the State's National Electric Vehicle Infrastructure (NEVI) Plan to address the
installation of DCFCs at former welcome centers in Vermont. This bill also
proposes to require the Agency of Transportation to provide a written report on
the feasibility of installing DCFCs at former welcome centers in Vermont with

1 the House and Senate Committees on Transportation not later than December
2 15, 2023.
