Subject: Crimes and criminal procedure; use of technology

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to require specific authorization from the General Assembly prior to the State or law enforcement using technology such as facial or tattoo recognition software, genetic DNA testing, stationary license plate readers, cell site simulators, and international mobile subscriber identity-catchers or purchasing, trading, or obtaining information from private or public entities gained from the use of such technology.

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
