14	§ 3581. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

16	(d)(1) Before obtaining a license for a dog or wolf-hybrid six months of
17	age or older, a person shall deliver to the municipal clerk a certificate or a
18	certified copy thereof issued by a duly licensed veterinarian, stating that the
19	dog or wolf-hybrid has received a current preexposure rabies vaccination with
20	a vaccine approved by the Secretary, and the person shall certify that the dog

1	or wolf-hybrid described in the certificate or copy is the dog or wolf-hybrid to
2	be licensed. The municipal clerk shall keep the certificates or copies thereof
3	on file. The Secretary shall prescribe the size and format of rabies certificates.
4	The owner of any such dog or wolf-hybrid shall maintain a copy of the rabies
5	vaccination form certificate and provide it to State or municipal officials upon
6	request.
7	(2) The rabies vaccination certificate shall include the following:
8	(A) the signature of the veterinarian;
9	(B) the dog or wolf-hybrid owner's name and address;
10	(C) the species, sex, age, color, and primary breed of the animal; and
11	(D) the vaccination number and expiration date.
12	(3) Veterinarians must present a list of rabies vaccinations to the
13	municipal clerk every 30 days.
