5 Subject: Alcoholic beverages; drink specials

6 Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to permit a first-
7 class licensee to sell malt and vinous beverages at a reduced price during a
8 period of not more than two hours each day. It also proposes to permit a third-
9 class licensee to sell spirits and fortified wines at a reduced price during a
10 period of not more than two hours each day.

12 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

13 Sec. 1. 7 V.S.A. § 221 is amended to read:

14 § 221. FIRST-CLASS LICENSES

15 * * *

16 (i) Each day, a first-class licensee may offer malt beverages or vinous
17 beverages, or both, at a temporarily reduced price for a period of not more than
18 two hours in duration. A licensee shall not offer any malt beverage or vinous
19 beverage for sale pursuant to this subsection at a price below the whole sale
20 purchase price for the beverage.
