2	(a) A local option sales tax is authorized under this section for the purpose
3	of affording the City an alternative method of raising municipal revenues with
4	the goal of lessening the impact of certain expenses on the property tax or
5	water and sewer fees, or both.
6	(b) The Board of Aldermen may authorize the assessment of a sales tax of
7	one percent.
8	(c) Any tax imposed under the authority of this section shall be collected
9	and administered by the Vermont Department of Taxes pursuant to 24 V.S.A.

11	(d) Pavanues received through a tax imposed under this section shall only
