15	(a) A person shall not knowingly possess a firearm at a polling place.
16	(b) A person who violates this section shall be imprisoned not more than
17	one year or fined not more than \$1,000.00, or both.

19	(1) firearms carried for legitimate law enforcement purposes by a
20	federal law enforcement officer or a law enforcement officer certified as a law

1	enforcement officer by the Vermont Criminal Justice Council pursuant to

3	(2) firearms carried by a person while preforming the person's official
4	duties as an employee of the United States; a department or agency of the

18	not more than \$250.00.
