15	permit under the regulations of the Board of Health on June 1, 1970 with
16	respect to plats on file as of June 1, 1970, provided such permit is granted
17	prior to August 1, 1970. Subsection (a) of this section shall not apply to
18	development that is not also a subdivision, which has been commenced prior
19	to June 1, 1970, if the construction will be completed by March 1, 1971.
